# Exploring the Role of Personal Advisors in Wales: A Co-Production Study with Care Experienced Young People

## Overview of the study The aim of this study

Each year a substantial number of young people leave the care system in Wales. These young people face significant challenges during this transition housing, related to education, employment, health and wellbeing. They frequently lack the support networks that are typically experienced by their peers. The support they receive during this time is therefore a critical determinant of their future wellbeing.

In Wales leaving care teams are required to appoint a personal advisor (PA) to each young person leaving care, to support them during this transition. Despite the importance of this role the practices of PAs are not well understood, and relatively little is known about how the role is perceived and experienced.
